- The first attachment will have more legible dimensions. I am sorry they did not come through more clearer the
 first time.
- 2. The second attachment will also have the elevation depicted more clearly.
- 3. With all due respect, I don't understand the 32 SF maximum allowable size for a wall sign. I am in a plaza where the smallest sign is much bigger than the one applied for. Planet Fitness, right next to me, has an enormous sign. A 32 SF sign will look miniscule next to this. I do not want customers questioning my company's lack of willingness to invest in an appropriate sign. Attached are also examples of the signs that my neighbors have.

Hello Eileen,

I took a look at the permit you are referencing. The dimensions on the drawing are illegible. The elevation drawing is also difficult to read.

Per the fee calculation, the size of the proposed sign is 94.7 SF. The maximum allowable size for a wall sign in this district is 32 SF. Accordingly, this application is denied pursuant to 375-4(1)(5)(a)(i) of the City Code.
